The corneal donations were made by Association of Physicians of Pakistani descent in North America (APPNA) and the Pakistan Association of memphis (MAP). It was a distinct achievement of the consultant ophthalmologist Mohi-ud-din Teaching Hospital Three transplant surgeries were performed in total.

➤ Model Exhibition by Pathology Department:



College Gymnasium Inauguration by the Principal

A healthy body is a pre-requisite for a healthy mind. The Gymnasium activity helps students and other personnel to improve their physical and mental health. Exercise or brisk physical activity has a soothing effect upon mind thus improving the mental concentration and mental absorbing capacity of students in their stressful academic pursuits. Due to its essence, a very well equipped exercise gymnasium has been established in the Boys hostel which was inaugurated by the principal Mohi-ud-din Islamic Medical College on 7th July 2020. The gymnasium remains open for desirous male students and other personnel for two hours during evening on the working days





Animal House

The animal house facility is available in the college to boost the teaching, training and research facilities. It is managed by the Department of Pharmacology. It has rabbits, frogs and a sheep. each is housed in barrier maintained rooms to avoid disease transmission and interspecies conflict. The animal house keeper ensures careful monitoring of feeding, watering, cage cleaning, bedding, material availability and other basic requirements.

Due to more sensitive nature of Sheep's RBCs to the released bacterial toxins than the human blood, the sheep blood is used as media(blood agar) to observe the hemolytic reaction around the grown bacterial colonies Sheep has been made available for this purpose in the animal house of the college.





LIBRARY

The College's Central library has a rich reservoir of about 5008 books (616 Islamic books, 68 Medical generals and 09 International generals books) pertaining the modern medical sciences/literature and religious studies. It is kept open for male and female students at separate timings during evenings on the working days. Its digitalization process is in progress which will aid students to gain access to the presentations, pdf version of books and medical journals on their handheld devices.



Workshop on Communication Skills

Disseminating and infusing the message in a clear, coherent and logical manner is a critical skill required to be possessed by the medical/ health professionals. Acknowledging its significance, Director Medical Education Dr. Saif Ullah Sial organized a workshop on 'Communication Skills' on 3rd March 2020 whose main facilitator and chief guest was Dr. "Fauzia Abdus Samad". This activity provided an impetus to the participants to become a better communicator, develop the trait to appreciate the art of conversation in the role as a speaker, listener and observe as well as learn how to create a conducive environment by communicating through empathy.





Workshop on Entrustable Professional Activities

In an increasingly complex and costly health care system, the clinical educators require to make right decisions about their objectives to disseminate palatable/ practicable clinical education to their students during any clinical interaction with them. The strategy must be result oriented and productive. The Director Medical Education MIMC Dr. Saif Ullah Sial orchestrated a workshop on the topic 'Entrustable Professional Activities for "Devolution of professional responsibilities to Tomorrow Doctor's" on 4th March 2020 and invited highly experienced / renowned expertise as guess speakers. Dr. Khalid Rahim & Dr. Ambreen Khalid were the lead facilitators for the event. This workshop helped the participants to gain a shared mental model of learner behaviours and aided them to integrate



competencies into the authentic care of patients by means of required level of supervision rather than level of learner competence.


Medical and Awarness Activites During Covid-19 Covid-19 Awareness Session Arranged for Medical Professionals

The chances of its recurrence are still looming due to lack of any vaccine. An awareness session was held in Pathology Dept on 8th June 2020. Provision of Quarantine Centres Facility by College & Hospital

They included Barrister Sultan Mehmood MLA AJ&K Assembly from Mirpur constituency, Deputy Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner Mirpur, District Health officer Mirpur, Chairman KORT, Drug inspector Mirpur and MS New City Teaching Hospital. The Faculty Hostel of college and the Mohi-uddin Teaching Hospital Ward were released by local District Management Authority on 17 July and 17 August respectively from quarantine responsibilities with appreciation to the college and hospital. Moreover, fulfilling the requirement of Islamabad Health Regulatory Authority (IHRA), Mohi-ud-din Teaching Hospital earmarked and kept 250 beds in state of high readiness



for the Co<mark>rona pati</mark>ents. In recognition to rendering meritorious services for quarantine purpose during COVID_19 pandemic, DC Mirpur issued the "Letter of Appreciation" to the College and Mohi-ud-din Teaching Hospital.
