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## Preface

Mohi-ud-Din Islamic University Nerian Sharif AJ&K is chartered by the Government of AJ&K and is recognized by Higher Education Commission, Govt of Pakistan. Mohi-ud-Din Islamic Medical College, Mirpur (MIMC) is the first medical institution established in AJ&K. It is located in sector D of New Industrial Area, Mirpur, having a covered area of 3.5 million sq. feet. The first MBBS class was started on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2009 as late session of 2008. The college has been allowed to admit 100 students in each batch.

Mohi-ud-Din Islamic Medical College (MIMC) has been accredited by Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC) and duly approved by the Ministry of Health, Government of Pakistan. Mohi-ud-Din Teaching Hospital, a state of the art 500 bedded hospital has been constructed in the college campus. It has all specialities including the Dentistry Department.

There is no dearth of medical colleges in Pakistan. After entry of private sector in the field of professional education, the number of medical colleges has increased manifold. The founder Chancellor Hazrat Allama Pir Alla-ud-Din Siddiqui R.A (late) had taken a noble initiative to produce high profile motivated medical professionals with Islamic spirit of service and sacrifice for the ailing humanity. To make a notable difference, the college has been established as residential institution to educate and train the youth as noble human torch bearers for the society.

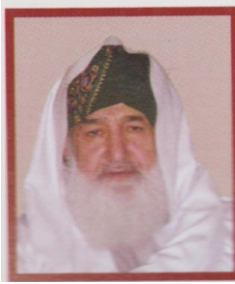

Doctor of Pharmacy is a semester based program comprising of 10 semesters in 5 years, following the latest curriculum to produce market demanded Pharmacists acceptable nationally as well as internationally.

The university has planned to add new programs like Dentistry. These programs will help to develop a state of the art medical city in the suburbs of Mirpur.

During the natural calamities/disasters like earthquake, Pandemics/ Epidemic etc. Mohi-ud-Din Teaching Hospital renders its health care services voluntarily to treat the affected patients to cherish its noble mission of helping the ailing humanity in the crises situation

## **MOHI-UD-DIN ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY NERIAN SHARIF AJ&K**

The University was established under Mohi-ud-Din Islamic University Act 1999 passed by the Legislative Assembly of Azad Jammu & Kashmir. The main objective underlying the establishment of the university, is to produce graduates equipped with modern knowledge in combination with the basic religious education to meet the challenges of new millennium.

The Higher Education Commission (HEC) has affirmed the equivalence of the degree diplomas and certificates awarded by the University with the corresponding degrees, diplomas and certificates of other universities in Pakistan. The main campus of the University is located at a beautiful hill station with its majestic multi-storeyed building at Nerian Sharif (Tararkhal), Azad Jammu and Kashmir. The main campus spreads over 10 acres of land and is situated at about 6,000 feet above the sea level. It has enchanting surroundings and fascinating natural environment. Nerian Sharif is situated to the North East of Islamabad at a distance of 125 km.

The establishment of Mohi-ud-Din Islamic University under the patronage and able guidance of the founder chancellor Hazrat Pir Alla-ud-Din Siddiqui RA (late) has been a real blessing of Allah Almighty in the economically backward area of Azad Jammu & Kashmir. The university offers 13 programs from BS to PhD at the main campus. MPhil and PhD programs are offered in education, Islamic Studies and mathematics whereas only MPhil degree program are offered in Biotechnology, Botany, Chemistry and Computer Science & IT.

### **Vision**

To enhance our national and international recognition as a medical college of the first rank, known for excellence in the disciplines of teaching, research and service with the assimilation of Islamic values.

### **Mission**

Mohi-ud-Din Islamic Medical College has been established with the aim of producing dignified young doctors with spirit of islamic values, proud of their heritage, Islamic traditions and free of complexes. It is embarked with the mission to produce quality medical professionals and well skilled human capital in the field of medicine for the welfare of Pakistani nation in particular and for the humanity in general.

### **Location**

The Mohi-ud-Din Islamic College is located in the south east of Mangla Dam in the beautiful city of Mirpur, AJ&K. The college is located in the industrial area, 5 km from down town. Mirpur city is situated in the south east of Islamabad at 2 hours drive and linked with G.T. Road at Dina at a distance of 25 Kilometers. Mirpur is one of the major cities of AJ&K located at its southern border. It has been redesigned and built after the demolition of old city over which Mangla Dam was constructed. Mirpur city is a beautiful blend of old and new civilization enriched with culture heritage. Extreme weather is observed in Mirpur especially during summer.

### **Medium of Instruction**

The medium of instruction is English. A foreign candidate is required to submit a certificate from the head of institution last attended to the effect that he/she can read, write and speak English fluently and that the medium of instruction was English.



## The Faculty

The College is proud of having highly qualified and experienced faculty. The Heads of Department of Basic and Clinical Sciences are pivots in attaining academic excellence in their respective disciplines





## ADMINISTRATION

The college is headed by the Principal. The administrative functions are carried out on the principle of division of work where separate department/ branches like administration, human resource, accounts, student affairs, procurement, maintenance & repair and stores etc, function to provide necessary services.





## Security

Fool proof security environment has been provided within the premises, perimeter of the college and the affiliated teaching hospital by deploying well trained, highly disciplined and experienced security staff/ guards at key points for 24 hours. They have been hired from a private sector security company of good repute. The bulk of the security staff belongs to retired army soldiers. CCTV cameras have been installed at various locations in the college and hospital to monitor the academic activities in classrooms, outdoor and indoor patients' departments thereby keeping an eye on the activities of all personnel besides monitoring the security concerns and potential security threats.



## TEACHING DEPARTMENTS

### Department of Anatomy

The Department is located on ground floor with a well spacious Dissection Hall, a mortuary with one chiller for 8 dead body shelves, a separate well equipped lecture hall, seminar rooms, histology lab, departmental library and a museum. Dissection hall is air conditioned with a huge capacity for training more than 100 students at a time. Histology lab is equipped with microscopes. The department is headed by a qualified professor supported by a high profile faculty and ancillary staff.



### Department of Biochemistry

The Department is situated on ground floor of the Academic block. The department includes a lecture hall, a well-equipped lab, seminar/demonstration room, faculty offices and departmental library. The lecture hall is equipped with proper heating and cooling facilities, UPS, teaching aids, multimedia with screen, overhead projector and proper sound system. The department is headed by a highly qualified Professor, supported by highly efficient faculty and staff.



### Department of Physiology

The Department is situated on the first floor. The department has faculty offices, a well-equipped air conditioned lecture hall with audio visual facility to accommodate more than 100 students. There is a Lab with latest equipment and instruments. The department also has a conference room, demonstration rooms and a seminar room. There is a departmental library as well which has latest books pertaining to the subject. The department is having experienced and qualified faculty and technical staff.



## Department of Pathology

The department includes an excellent museum with precious specimens, air conditioned lecture hall with audio visual facility for more than 100 students, demonstration rooms and two well equipped students' labs. The department has highly qualified faculty members along with skillful technical/other staff. It also has its departmental library.



## Department of Pharmacology and Therapeutics

The department is located on the first floor. The department has state of the art museum having different sections like pharmacological preparations/drugs, classification charts, pharmacognosy and toxicology with relevant specimens. The museum is equipped with teaching aids and is also used as a demonstration room for 40 students. There are fully equipped demonstration rooms and an examination hall. The department has hi-tech lab and faculty offices. There is a separate animal house near the academic block. The department is headed by a highly experienced and well qualified professor duly supported by qualified faculty and technical staff.

### Auditorium

There is a spacious air conditioned siddiqui auditorium of 350 seats with proper sound system

## Department of Forensic Medicine

The department includes a lecture theater, a toxicology lab, forensic museum, demonstration rooms and faculty offices. All rooms are properly furnished and well equipped. The department is headed by experienced, qualified professor along with other qualified faculty and staff.





## Department of Community Medicine

The department is located on the first floor. The department has a state of the art skills development laboratory and learning resource center. It has different sections, like section of primary health care, vaccines, contraceptive devices, entomology, filtration plants, infectious diseases, nutrition, tiers of health care and many more. Hall and corridor of the department are full of charts and learning aids for the students. The students are imparted instruction and demonstration in the resource center. In addition, there is a lecture hall and offices for the faculty. Department is headed by a highly qualified and experienced professor and supported by well experienced and qualified faculty and staff.



## Department of Medical Education

The department of medical education is located on the first floor adjacent to the Siddiqui Auditorium. It has a well qualified, dynamic and dedicated Head of Department, efficient faculty members and supporting staff.

## Skills Learning Lab

This lab is well equipped with various models, dummies and other accessories/learning tools where students are given practical demonstrations and made conversant with the medical emergency /other procedures in the practical domains of patient's health care. It is managed by a highly qualified, dedicated and experienced faculty member.



## Department of Islamic/Pakistan Studies

The department is located on first floor adjacent to the library. It has a highly experienced head/ religious teacher along required staff. The department besides having modern facilities, has a collection of about 1000 Islamic books on different topics.



## Nurses and Paramedics Training

Mohi-ud-Din Institute of Nursing and Allied Sciences (MINAS) has been duly recognized by Pakistan Nursing Council. It has started functioning since 15th February 2021. It will cater for the nursing care needs of the teaching hospital, and will also be a rich source to provide trained nursing human resource for AJ&K and Pakistan. It has highly qualified and well experienced teaching faculty along with efficient supporting staff. It is a constituent institute of Mohi-ud-Din Islamic University



## Mohi-ud-Din Institute of Rehabilitation Sciences (MIRS)

It has also started functioning since November 2020 with the classes of first batch already underway. It is also a constituent institute of Mohi-ud-Din Islamic University

## EDUCATIONAL AND SOCIAL FACILITIES

The College provides state of the art facilities for professional development and application of knowledge. It also has residential and other educational facilities as described below.

### Computer Lab and Network Connectivity

Information technology is an area which is mandatory for every professional in the present era of modern technology. A well-equipped IT laboratory has been established where skills in the use of computer are taught and polished. All computers are connected through LAN. Internet facility is available to help students keep themselves abreast with latest techniques in the field of information technology and medical discipline. Internet facility has been provided to the students for educational purpose in compliance to the PMC policy. There is well developed capacity to conduct online classes. The college and hospital are being provided with the services of management, instructional and medical information system through the network connectivity . It has immensely contributed to the speedy, efficient delivery and working of health care system to the clientele, storage of data and swift working of all departments of the college.



### Hostels

Hostel accommodation is provided to all students except those belonging to Mirpur City. There are two separate hostels for about five hundred male and female students which are well segregated from each other. Each hostel is managed by separate warden. The hostels are equipped with all requisite facilities. The student rooms are fully carpeted. The rooms are fully furnished and also provided with study tables and cupboards for each student. Students are only required to bring their own pillows with covers, bed sheets and blankets. A separate hostel for staff is available. Limited lower staff residential accommodation also exists. There is a well-managed faculty hostel to accommodate the teaching faculty members, including those belonging to the distant and far-flung areas of the country. Its rooms are spacious and properly furnished.



### Book Shops

In order to ensure the prompt and cost effective provision of books of different medical sciences / literature to the students, Two separate students book shops( in each hostel) have been established in the college premises. These shops remain open during working hours and the evening time.

### Students Mess

The boys and girls messes are well apart from each other and there are separate dining halls for boys and girls. Charges are as per expenditure. To facilitate efficient functioning, appropriate mess rules / regulations have been formulated which are being practised. There is a Mess Committee which holds its meetings periodically to keep an eye on the quality of food and catering services being rendered besides addressing the relevant problems faced by the dining members during routine functioning.



### Canteen/Cafeteria and Fruit Shop Facility

Separate canteen/cafeteria and fruit shop facilities are available for male and female students, college employees within the college campus adjacent to respective hostels. Cafeterias, fruit shops remain open from 6:00am to 12:00pm. The cafeteria is also providing the fast food services of high quality. Mohi-Ud-Din Teaching hospital has two separate canteens which are meant to provide meal, allied food/bakery item services to the patients, their attendants, and hospital staff/doctors on their demand.

### Barber Shop

It is located close to the Boys Hostel and is providing services efficiently to the male students and college

## Co-Curricular Activities

### Sports

Healthy body is essential for healthy mind. The sports activities amongst students not only inculcate the sportsman spirit in them but also enhance their physical and mental alertness. Various outdoor and indoor sports activities are organized in the college.

An excellent gymnasium equipped with the latest exercise machines has been established in the Boys hostel for the male students and other personnel of the college to help them maintain and promote their physical fitness and well being. It remains open in the evening during working days



The college holds its Annual Sports Week with great fervor regularly. Students participate in it with keen interest. Separate sports events are organized for the boys, girls, faculty members and staff of the college and hospital. There is a well maintained play-ground close to the hospital where students play outdoor games like cricket, hockey and football. A well maintained basket ball court is available for the boys adjacent to the Anatomy Block. Matches are also held with various teams of other educational institutions located in Mirpur. The facilities for indoor games like badminton and table tennis are also available in boys and girls hostels.

### Excursion Trips

Excursion Trips for all classes are arranged regularly to any hilly station or historical/ famous site at the choice of students of concerned class. A fortnightly trip to Mirpur City, is arranged for the boarder girls enabling them to carry shopping etc.

### Debating/Literary Activities

These activities are held periodically to blossom the communication/speaking skills of the students and provide them a forum to develop self confidence and literary acumen

### Patients' Welfare Society

As a part of philanthropic and humanitarian help, the college students have organized a patients welfare society which renders monetary assistance to the needy employees and students of the college suffering from any disease/disorder requiring treatment beyond their affordability . One day carnival is held in the college premises under the sponsorship of college's administration. Different vendors from Mirpur City establish their stalls, sell their items to students, faculty members and other employees of the college and hospital on mutually agreed special rates. The earned profit is then donated to the patients welfare society





## Medical Care Facilities

Students are entitled for emergency treatment and admission at MOTH . However, medicines are provided for emergencies only. No drugs are provided on long term basis for chronic ailments and the diseases or disorders that are covered under cosmetic treatment e.g. treatment of acne etc. An inventory of common generic drugs is displayed to cover emergency treatment. Branded drugs prescribed by non-faculty doctors, are also not provided from the hospital.

MOTH has its own pharmacy shop in its premises to entertain the clientele. All emergency, routine treatment drugs and other medical treatment items are available at normal rates in it. It remains open throughout 24 hours.



## Transport

Transport is provided to the students from college to Mirpur city and back. The college has highly effective contingent of own transport including buses, ambulances, coasters etc .It is also providing free of cost shuttle service facility to the desirous patients from Mirpur city to MOTH and back. The ambulances remain on duty for 24 hours to cater for any emergency evacuation or shifting of patients.



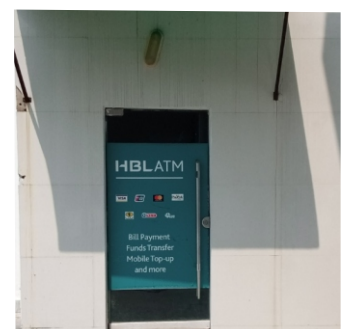
## Library

The central college library remains open for all students from 8:00 am till midnight. The facility is provided to male and female students at different timings on the same day. Separate reading rooms are also available. It has a rich reservoir of books in the fields of modern medical sciences, literature and religion. Separate departmental libraries also exist which contain the medical books of the particular subject in abundance.



## ATM Facility

The ATM facility has been provided within the college premises for students, faculty members and staff employees by Habib Bank Limited. The aim is to facilitate swift withdrawal of required cash by desirous persons at the doorstep in safe and secure college environment



## ADMISSION

Mohi-ud-Din Islamic Medical College (MIMC) Mirpur is open to all eligible candidates from anywhere in the world. The boys and girls from all over Pakistan, AJ&K and overseas can apply for admission. The admission is purely based on merit in accordance with the criteria and procedure laid down by Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC).

### Admission Procedure

1. Applicants for admission are invited through advertisements in leading national English and Urdu newspapers well before the start of the academic session. The last date for submission of applications is notified therein.
2. Foreign students seeking admission in MIMC should submit their applications along with the application fee through their Embassies/High Commissions of Pakistan.
3. As per the admission policy of PMC, 20% marks are to be awarded by the interviewing panel of concerned college through the structured interview to the appearing candidate which are then included in the total aggregate MDCAT result.

### Wealth Statement & Insurance Certificate

As per the existing PMC rule, an applicant desirous of admission in private medical and dental Institution shall submit a wealth statement of either parent/guardian, equivalent to five years tuition fee, income tax return of either parent/ guardian and shall also submit insurance certificate to ensure the payment of fees for remaining duration of the course of demise of parent/guardian.

## Number of seats

There are one hundred (100) seats available each year for admission. The seats are distributed as under:

### a. Open Merit

## Eligibility Criteria for Admission

The applicant must have secured at least 65% marks in the HSSC (Intermediate Pre-Medical) Examination from a Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education in Pakistan or an equivalent foreign qualification.

## Equivalence Certificate

It is the responsibility of all those candidates having foreign qualification i.e. other than HSSC/F.S.C (Premedical) from Pakistan, to obtain recognition of their qualification and equivalence certificates from the Inter-Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC), Islamabad.

## Documents to be Attached with the Application Form

A candidate, who is eligible for admission, must submit attested copies (as indicated against each) of the following documents along with the application form and bank draft covering the application and processing fee:

These documents should be posted through a reliable service or delivered in person to the college in Mirpur or, Islamabad Camp office from Monday to Thursday between 09:00 am to 02:00 pm and up to 11:00 am on Friday on or before the last date of receipt of the applications.

## Medical Examination Board

1. A Medical Board constituted by the university, will examine and interview the selected candidates to exclude any physical and mental ailment by the Physician, Psychiatrist and Psychologist. The candidates must be physically and mentally fit to be able to obtain medical education and be able to practice at least as a General duty medical officer/General practitioner. A candidate suffering from a communicable disease likely to affect student or his fellows or suffering from any other disease of serious concern, may be dropped.
2. The admission letter to overseas candidates will be issued provisionally and will only be confirmed when No Objection Certificate from the Ministry of Interior, Government of Pakistan is received and the candidate has a valid student/study visa. As per Government of Pakistan rules, the tourist or visit visas do not entitle a foreign national to seek admission in any educational institution in Pakistan.

## Student's Personal health information

Student and their parents are required to submit in writing on Rs. 100/-judicial Stamp paper that they themselves or their son/daughter are not suffering from any serious communicable disease or chronic ailment including mental disorder or disease with acute exacerbations. Any candidate later on found to be suffering from any of chronic ailment will be expelled from the college.

## Original Documents

All the candidates selected for admission will have to submit to the college authorities their original certificates of SSC or equivalent and HSSC or equivalent before joining the college. These certificates will be returned after graduation or at the time of their leaving the College.

The original documents of the admitted students shall be verified from the respective boards / University. If a student gets admission on bogus/forged documents, his/her admission shall be immediately cancelled and the fee and dues paid by him/her shall be forfeited. Students shall be responsible for this illegal action and the college/university may file a forgery case against such a student who shall face all the consequences. Such students shall have no right to go to the court of law.

## Undertaking

All students are required to submit duly notarized undertaking on Rs.100/- stamp paper before commencement of classes.

## Visitors of Female Students

The female boarders will bring prescribed Proforma duly signed by their parents/guardians along with the photographs & photocopies (duly attested) of CNIC of the persons concerned. Male visitors are not allowed to visit the girls hostel. The close relations with the names already shared or held in the warden office record by concerned student, are only permitted to see her.

## Scholarship for High Achievers

To encourage students with outstanding academic performance, the Founder Chancellor Hazrat Allama Pir Alla-ud-Din Siddiqui R.A (late) decided to award scholarship amounting to Rs. 20,00,00/- (rupees two lac only) each for first three position holders. In case a position is shared by two or more students, the amount of scholarship for that particular slot, will be equally divided among them.

## **ATTENDANCE**

80% attendance in lectures, practicals and other academic activities separately is essential for eligibility to appear in university examination.

## **LEAVE**

1. All leaves of absence will be granted by the Principal.
2. Sick leave will be granted on recommendation of a consultant/faculty member of MIMC or on production of medical certificate from registered medical practitioner in case of any medical emergency on weekends /vacations only.
3. Students residing in the hostel are not allowed to leave the campus without permission of the warden.
4. Leave for Hajj/Umrah will be sanctioned by competent authority on case to case basis only.

## **DISCIPLINE**

1. The students are required to abide by the rules and regulations of MIMC. The College/University expects and demands absolute integrity and honesty from its students concerning their day to day life in the college.
2. Unethical and unlawful behavior during examination or in college campus, hostel or at a public place anywhere else, may result in removal from the College/University rolls.
3. Other causes of removal will include submitting false documents, stealing, willful destruction of or damage to college equipment, furnishings or property, physical violence against other students/faculty members/staff/patients, use of intoxicating drugs, possession and use of arms/ammunition in the college/hostel, violation of civil rights of others, indulgence in political, subversive or union activities or working for political parties, organization of civil disturbance and non-payment of fee/dues etc
4. A student, who remains absent without leave for a period of four consecutive weeks, will be struck off the college rolls. He /She may, however, be readmitted on the recommendation of the college Academic Committee and on deposit of readmission fee as a fresh student only.

6. The use of cell phone in college and hospital during study/working hour is prohibited.

## **ASSESSMENTS AND EXAMINATION**

1. Minimum 80% attendance and completion of the log book is required for a student to be eligible for module/clerkship and certifying examination (s).
2. The assessment techniques/tools used are appropriate for the learning outcomes, the level of the learner and the domains tested.
3. Formative and summative assessment: The same tools may be used for formative or summative assessment. Formative assessment will be used only for feedback to develop the learners, while summative assessments will be used to make pass/fail or progress decision. Any assessment where the results contribute to a final score, and leads to a decision of the progress of the students, are considered summative.
4. Feedback to students is provided after both formative and summative assessments.
5. Summative assessment consists of the sum of the continuous assessments score (Internal assessment based on assessment of student performance during the module or clerkship) and end of year university examination.
6. Re-sit examination. There may be opportunities for Re-sit examination for the summative component of continuous assessment and end of year assessment.
7. University Examination will be held at the end of each academic year.

### **Internal Evaluation**

An Internal Evaluation is carried out at regular intervals at the end of each term. It is carried out in the form of periodic tests, term tests and sendup test after the completion of a prescribed course of lectures, demonstrations and clinical work. The internal evaluation score will constitute 10% of the total marks allocated to each subject of the MBBS program in all the professional examinations. The internal evaluation will consist of the following:

1. Continuous Assessment Test: Monthly
2. Term Test: After every 11 to 13 weeks.
3. Send-up Test: About one month prior to each professional examination, a send-up/ pre-professional examination test, covering the entire course consisting of theory exam, viva and OSPE/OSCE will be conducted by the college. Passing marks in continuous assessment test, term test and in send up test are 50%

### **External Evaluation/ University Examination**

1. As per the university rules, the candidates having less than 80% attendance in lectures/demonstrations /practical/tutorials or clinical hours of any subject, will not be admitted to Annual Professional Examination of the University.
2. The leave availed by student will not be considered as acceptable and will affect the 80% attendance(not considered as the contact hour(s))
3. Before each professional examination, the student will have to produce a 'No Dues Certificate' on a prescribed proforma. Those students, who fail to produce the required certificate, will not be permitted to sit in the professional examination.

## **OTHER OBLIGATIONS**

1. The Principal has the authority to restrain a student at any stage, a student from appearing in the professional MBBS Examination of the university on the basis of ill-discipline, shortage of attendance and poor academic performance, besides if in the Principal's opinion, the student has conduct or character, unbecoming of a medical student.
2. Minimum passing marks for each subject in every examination are 50% which are to be obtained separately in theory and in viva voce/OSCE/OSPE.
3. On completion of professional university examination, the students will provisionally be promoted to the next higher class. On announcement of the result by the university, all such students who are declared as failed, will be allowed to continue their studies with the next higher class till result of supplementary examination is declared. No student will be promoted to next higher class unless he/she is declared successful in supplementary examination.
4. The students who fail even in the supplementary examination of the university, will have to attend lectures/practical/tutorials/clinical with the class to which they are relegated. It will be mandatory for such students to once again attend at least 80% of the prescribed academic activities (lectures/practical/tutorials/clinical etc.) For the remaining time of the college hours, they will carry out supervised self-study or attend academics in the concerned department. In such cases the lectures, practicals, clinical demonstrations, attended during their provisional promotion shall stand cancelled.
5. The students who failed to clear the first professional MBBS examination in four attempts availed or unavailed after becoming eligible for examination, shall cease to become eligible for further medical and dental education in Pakistan.
6. The use of unfair means in internal examination will be reported to the Principal while such cases in professional examination will be reported to the University for appropriate action against concerned student.




